

101 ANNUAL EDUCATION RESULTS REPORT

Background

The school jurisdiction is required by Alberta Education to prepare an Annual Education Results Report, which provides a means by which the Division can report the results of its educational program to the public and to Alberta Education.

The Division recognizes its responsibility to keep stakeholders informed about accomplishments and work toward goals and will keep its school communities and the public informed of the overall results achieved in the Division.

Procedures

1. An Annual Education Results Report shall be produced to provide information to the public on progress towards achieving the goals and results desired in the Division Education Plan.
2. The Annual Education Results Report shall contain the results on mandatory and optional measures gathered through the year from such activities as ongoing reviews, evaluations, surveys, planning sessions and workshops.
3. The Annual Education Results Report shall be a foundation document in developing the Division Education Plan and/or identifying strategies for effecting improvements.
4. The format for reporting mandatory measures shall comply with standards specified by Alberta Education.
5. The format for reporting optional measures and additional information in the Division Annual Education Results Report will be determined by the Superintendent.
6. The Superintendent shall:
 - a. Ensure that a combined Three Year Plan / Annual Education Results Report is prepared for Board approval at or before its regular November meeting; and
 - b. Ensure the Annual Education Results Report is submitted to Alberta Education in a form and at a time that meets requirements.
7. The Annual Education Results Report shall be made available to the public in a summary or special report format.
