

391 STUDENT RECOGNITION/AWARDS

The Division supports the recognition of performance and effort by students in all aspects of education. Achievements may include, but are not exclusive to academics, athletics, fine arts, practical arts, and voluntary activities.

The Division encourages the provision of scholarships/bursaries for academic and other forms of excellence, proficiency, and progress. The terms of reference and criteria for such scholarships and other forms of student achievement shall be developed at each school and are subject to school administrative review each school year.

Procedures

1. Principals and staff are to establish awards to be given to students at the beginning of each school year.
2. Principals are to provide information with respect to available awards and scholarships in a timely manner to all eligible students.
3. Selection of recipients shall be based upon predetermined criteria.
4. Funds held in trust at the Division level shall be managed in accordance with:
 - a. Conditions agreed upon, at time of establishment; and
 - b. Current Division procedures.
5. Funds held at the school level shall be managed in accordance with:
 - a. Conditions agreed upon at the time of establishment and;
 - b. Current Division procedures.
6. Donors shall be appropriately acknowledged.

7. Grades 9-12 - Honour Roll shall be awarded based on the following minimum criteria:
 - a. Alberta Education [Alexander Rutherford Scholarship Criteria](#).
 - b. Schools may set additional criteria as long as this minimum is met.

NOTE: All courses must be at the same level e.g., Grade 9, 10, 11 or 12.

Celebration and recognition of honour roll and student achievement will occur on an annual basis.
