Transformational Learning Opportunities

- Future Ready Skills To ensure students are equipped with the essential skills, values, and knowledge to thrive in a rapidly changing world, increased investments in literacy, numeracy and future ready skills are necessary for all students - particularly those in vulnerable sectors.
- **Funding Security** To safeguard students' future, the province need to commit to a resource allocation framework, like its Weighted Moving Average, to ensure smaller boards do not need to rely on external funding to support transformational learning opportunities.

Continuity of Learning

Provincial Partnerships - To ensure students' continuity of learning, collaboration and active engagement among all provincial partners is needed to secure funding solutions that address the unique financial burdens like lack of housing and the cost of living in the Bow Valley corridor.
