GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Responsibilities include:

- Set up, operate, and maintain sound, projection, and lighting equipment for a variety of rental events
- Troubleshoot and resolve any technical issues that arise during events
- Ensure proper storage and care of equipment before and after events
- Manage all aspects and equipment related to lighting and sound
- Operation of light/sound equipment and
- Conduct sound checks

- Proven experience in operating sound, projection, and lighting equipment in a live event setting
- Proficiency with sound mixing consoles, lighting control boards, and related technical equipment
- Strong knowledge of audio and lighting principles and techniques
